University of Ottawa, Division of Geriatrics Travel to Rural Clinics policy for trainees (residents and students)

1. Trainees are not to be expected to travel long distances during inclement weather (or when inclement weather is predicted ex. snow storm) for clinical or other academic assignments. If such weather prevents travel, the trainee is expected to contact the Geriatric program office promptly. The trainee will be assigned to an alternate activity.
2. The trainee will be invited to join the Geriatrician in their car on route to the clinic. At all times a professional climate must prevail while travelling together, such as would occur in an academic setting. The trainee can expect to travel in a well maintained car and has the option to travel separately if there is cause for concern. In that situation the trainee would inform the Geriatrician/Program coordinator, and travel to the rural clinic on their own.
